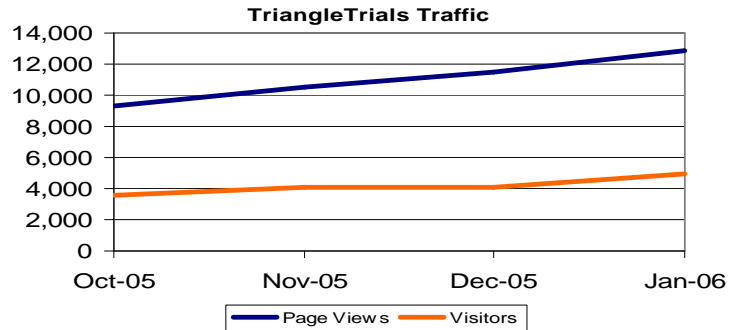


TriangleTrials

TriangleTrials.com helps Triangle residents find clinical trials that are relevant to their healthcare interests. TriangleTrials uses a website and email newsletters to present information about locally recruiting clinical trials and relevant health news.

The website and newsletter were launched in April 2005. Traffic and newsletter subscriptions are growing continuously. Each week 3 to 5 new newsletter subscribers join and website traffic ranges from 400 to 500 page views per day.



During the development phase of TriangleTrials, clinical trial listings have been culled from local newspapers. TriangleTrials is currently offering sponsored listings for very little cost. Sponsoring a listing entitles your organization to prominent exposure throughout the website and in the weekly newsletter.

Sponsors who join now are invited to suggest new features for the website that will benefit both the sponsor and TriangleTrials visitors.

Adding your trials is easy: Simply provide the following pieces of information in a Word document:

- Title
- Category
- Description: Specify subject and basic inclusion/exclusion criteria. IRB approved benefits and compensation if available.
- IRB #: If available
- Contact information
